Our society was formed some 35 years ago with the aim of Preserving the Environment of the Village of Linton.

The Society has a management committee which comprises of a Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer, plus three additional Committee Members, and serve in office for a one year period.

The Annual General Meeting is held in Spring of each year at the Linton Village Memorial Hall and at least 14 days prior notice is provided and everyone in the village is invited. The end of the meeting is followed by a Glass of Wine to meet up with other Residents from the Village.

We hold open meetings as necessary when local circumstances dictate and committee meetings are held on a more regular basis to deal with ongoing Village matters.

Our Society has a good relationship with other local organisations and in particular with all our Ward Councillors, Member of Parliament and Parish Councillors, which helps us to get many tasks carried out.

Subscriptions to our Society are determined at the Annual General Meeting and is currently a £30 minimum subscription from the 1st June each year for each household. We endeavour to maintain a fund in order that we can meet any professional representation to deal with any major issues that could threaten or Village, as we have done previously.

In the last few years the Society has been involved in a number of issues related to the aims of the Society and some are listed below:-

Planning Issues - Objections and Appeals. Meeting with Developers

Traffic Issues - Liaising with Leeds City Council and the Police relating to speed restrictions and traffic volumes

Noise and Pollution - Representation at the A1(M) upgrade Public Enquiry

Tree Preservation Orders - Applied for as and where required

Liaison - Liaising on the formation of the Neighbourhood Plan, The Parish Plan, The Village Design Statement
